April VCCA Meeting March 13th, 7 pm

The Monthly VCCA meeting will be on **Monday**, **April 13th at 7:00 PM** at Café Ginger, located at 1952 West Gray Street in the shopping center near the intersection with Driscoll. The speaker for the April meeting is Melanie Scruggs, Houston Program Director for

Texas Campaign for the Environment (TCE).

TCE is a statewide non-profit advocacy group that focuses on grassroots campaigns to protect natural resources and spur a more engaged democracy. Some of TCE's major

victories include expanding curbside recycling in Houston, and passing Zero Waste Plans including single-use bag ordinances in Austin and Dallas. Melanie is a graduate of UT Austin in the Plan II Honors program, a TCE staff member since 2012, and she serves on the Houston Clean City Commission, Keep Houston Beautiful.

TCE urges you to contact your state lawmakers to support a proposed battery recycling bill during the 2015 Texas Legislative Session and to weigh in on several other important environmental issues. For example, many cities have passed local ordinances to address environmental problems caused by single-use plastic bags and polluting industries such as oil and gas drilling. However, state lawmakers are considering bills that would preempt this right to local control. In addition, lawmakers are considering HB 1247, HB 1865, and SB 709, which would diminish the rights of Tex-

ans living near landfills and other polluting facilities to challenge them in a court-like process called a "contested case hearing" by shifting the burden of evidence to residents instead of polluters. Lawmakers are considering several bills that would preempt local ordinances:



- HB 539, SB 360, SB 440 and SB 720 would over-ride strong local gas drilling ordinances;
- HB 190, HB 1442 and HB 1472 would interfere with local tree preservation ordinances;
- HB 540 would force cities to obtain permission from the state before holding local referendums;
- SB 343 would undo local ordinances that are stronger than state law.

TCE will cover these issues and the environment in general during Melanie's talk on April 13th. Don't miss it!


VCCA Yard of the Month 1806 McDuffie
