MEET YOUR NEIGHBORS - WILLY COLLINS



Willy Collins, a 10-year resident of Vermont Commons, can be seen diligently tending his beautiful garden on McDuffie. VCCA previously recognized him for his green thumb with the Yard of the Month awards. You can also watch him walk his four rescue dogs - he is quite dexterous to be able to handle all of them on leads at once!

However, his real claim to fame is his music. Willy grew up in Staten Island, New York, where as a teenager he played bass guitar in a local garage band. After living in Orlando and attending University of Central Florida, he moved to Houston completed law school and began his legal career at V&E. He is now practices law full-time with Sheehy Ware Pappas, where he specializes in truck accident and products liability litigation. Twelve years ago, he became reacquainted with playing music after buying his daughter Ashlyne an acoustic guitar to encourage her to learn to play. He joined her in lessons from the late Joe Romano and then entered the Berklee College of Music's online songwriting program. After graduating he began

writing songs and with the help from friends David Berkeley, Jordan Katz and Guy Strauss, recorded his first project in Atlanta in partnership with Will Robinson. Willy Released his first EP *Benevolent Lies* in 2012, and formed The Willy Collins Band band with several great Houston musicians, recording multiple records at Houston's famed Sugar Hill Studios.

After the band broke up, Willy started a new band with Joshua Lee Hammond called Londale, named after Willy's first transistor. Together with several musicians, they recorded and released three critically-acclaimed records. With the current lineup of Hammond (lead guitar), Alex Lambert (rhythm guitar), Cory Martin (bass guitar) and Gabe Bravo (drums) the band released its latest album Achilles in April 2019. Willy writes most of the lyrics, and he and his bandmates write the music. Willy describes the music as Indi-Rock with heavy 90's era influence. The band has performed at local music festivals and several venues around Houston. including the Continental Club, White Oak Music Hall, Rockefellers and many other sites.
