## **Highlights from the VCCA Directors Meeting**



The VCCA Directors Meeting was held on January 13, 2025, at Churrasco's. Directors and Officers present were Jeanette Hix, Stephanie Taylor, Lisa Meyer, Janet Meyer, Ann Terrell, Andy Tallin and Kay Johnson.

The Treasurer's Report noted VCCA ended 2024 with a balance of \$12,772. Membership for 2024-25 is significantly down from the prior year. We had 154 members in 2023-24, compared to only 95 in 2024-25, causing a shortfall in our budget of \$2,000. Major costs for 2024 were the Holiday Party, Volunteer Appreciation event and the Picnic. Advertising covers the cost of the newsletter with added costs for the membership enrollment flyer and the annual color issue.

Reminders will be sent to those who have not yet paid dues for the 2024-25 year, and we are already discussing plans to promote membership at the opening of the 2025-26 year, which begins in September.

New projects include contacting the city to request new stickers for the recycle bins, and promoting the CitizensNet and Alert Houston programs, city notification systems that provide residents with timely information, especially during weather or special events when regular procedures may be changed (see page 3).


